As it does on many projects in urban areas, the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) is working closely with local officials in Zionsville to plan the 421 Forward corridor improvements.

As part of standard practice, INDOT typically does not include trails as part of its work, but the project team works closely with local officials to plan where pedestrian facilities will be.

On projects like 421 Forward, INDOT has been working closely with Zionsville to plan and study the final design's details and where the town can build trail access for residents.
